

EXPERIENCE OF TOOTH DECAY


Proportion of children with at least one decayed, missing or filled primary (baby) or permanent (adult) tooth²

Average number of decayed, missing or filled primary (baby) or permanent (adult) teeth²






SMOKING STATUS

Proportion of daily smokers³






FOOD INSECURITY
